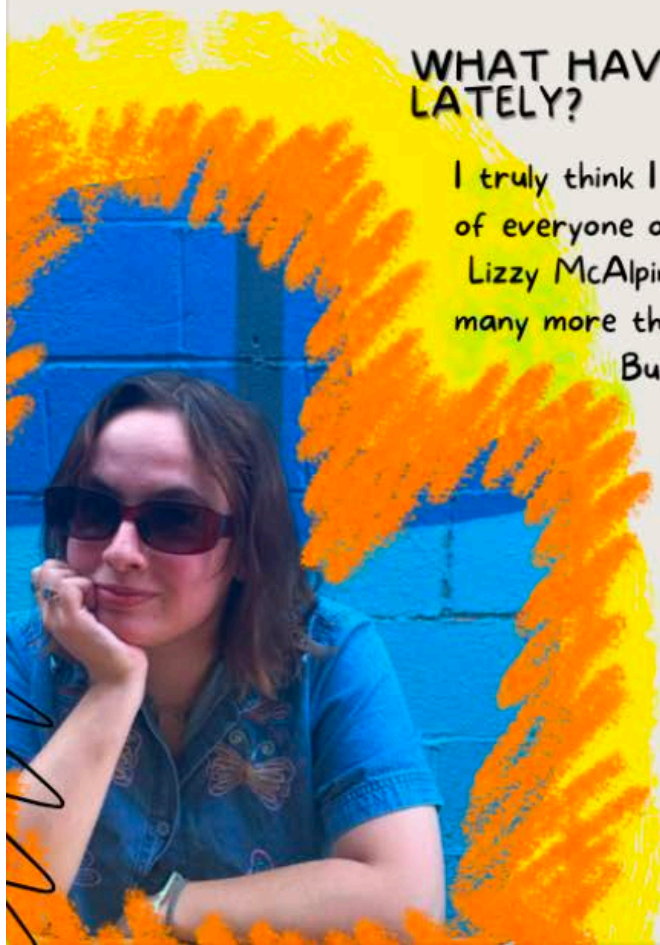
## WHAT HAVE YOU BEEN LISTENING TO LATELY?

## WHAT MADE YOU WANT TO RUN THE 50 HOUR MARATHON?

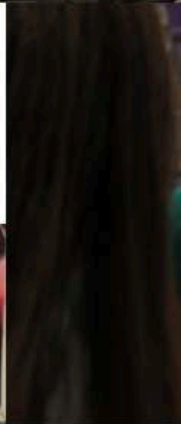
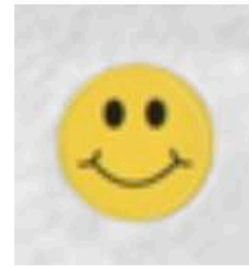

## WHAT ADVICE DO YOU HAVE FOR THE 50 HOUR DJS?

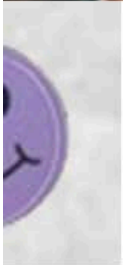

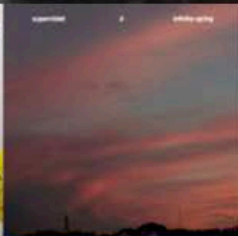
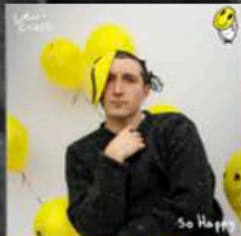
While The Advocacy Center

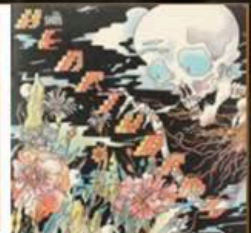
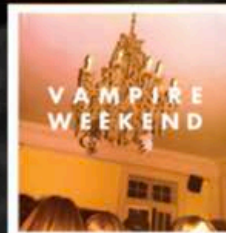
